Relationships are the Key to Establishing an Effective Policy on Climate Change

Although 97% of climate scientists agree with the conclusion that human activities are driving climate change far beyond the range of natural variability, with very serious consequences for future generations, the U.S. still lacks a climate policy that is effective enough to prevent a warming exceeding 5 F. In this talk, climate scientist Steve Ghan will describe a path forward that can overcome the obstacles to a durable and effective national and international climate policy.



Steven Ghan is a widely published climate scientist with a doctorate in Meteorology from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He is internationally recognized for his expertise in representing the effects of aerosol particles on clouds and climate in global climate models. He leads the Tri-Cities Washington Chapter of Citizens Climate Lobby.
